



HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Churches and schools identify potential leaders and nominate them to attend an Exodus Prime camp.
- The church or school provides a mentor to meet with the student once per month for the 12 months following camp.
- Exodus Prime provides all the resources for the mentor.
- The student pledges to meet with their mentor and to put what they are learning into practice in their church, school and local community.
- Exodus Prime runs on a four-year cycle with each year as a stand-alone course. Students who return will build on what they have learnt previously.
- Students will receive a certificate of graduation at the end of their 4 years.



WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Year 10 to 13 students who are identified by their churches or schools as having:

- significant leadership potential
- readiness to develop personally and as a Christian leader

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

\$250 covers all meals, accommodation and resources for the five day Exodus Prime camp, plus the training and resources for the 12-month mentorship programme. We strongly encourage churches and schools to support their emerging leaders with sponsorship and fundraising assistance.
